## **Application for ERASMUS+- and Guest Students**

Information for those who will attend lectures within the ERASMUS+-Programme or as an international guest student at the Faculty of Business Studies of the University of Applied Sciences Emden/Leer during fall semester, fall and spring semesters or spring semester.

Please contact your International Office at the home institution first. The International Office will inform you about the ERASMUS+ Programme and/or the application procedure at your home institution.

It is possible to apply with B1 in English to join the English Programme (not possible for German programmes), provided you enlist for the **pre-semester course "Bridging course English"**, where your attendance would be mandatory. This course is offered at the Hochschule Emden/Leer before lecture start as a special offer for students, who do not meet the requirements of B2 in English prior to their stay in Emden. Please note the limited amount of places in the pre-semester course.

After you have been nominated to study as an ERASMUS+ or an international guest student at the Faculty of Business Studies of the University of Applied Sciences Emden/Leer by your home institution, please fill in the **online application form**. Please register first and afterwards use the data for log - in.

After the deadline you will receive an information package from the International Office. The package includes information about the orientation weeks, about the intensive German language course and about accommodation possibilities.

## Dates in the fall semester:

## Dates in the spring semester:

- Orientation weeks incl. German hours intensive: three weeks before lectures start
- Courses/programmes including exam period: beginning of March mid of July
