

Information about COVID -19 Vaccination for Incomings

1. Eligibility to vaccinate

a) According to the vaccination prioritization:

If you belong to a prioritization group (2 or 3) - e.g. for medical reasons - you can register now and request an appointment at the vaccination center in your place of residence (see 3. Vaccination centers below).

b) Vaccination without prioritization:

As of June 7th, the vaccination prioritization will be lifted. This means that you can register for a vaccination appointment from June 7th:

However, you will not be able to make an appointment immediately, but will usually be placed on a waiting list.

Please note that most vaccines require a second vaccination, which can only be given after several weeks (exception: Johnson & Johnson). Your stay in Germany should therefore last during this period.

2. Registration

You can register for a vaccination via the vaccination portal of the state of Lower Saxony:

Please note that you have to provide proof of a place of residence in the catchment area of the vaccination center on the day of your first vaccination. This can be done by making a note in the ID card or another valid document (confirmation of registration from the Citizens' Office). Alternatively, you can have the International Office issue a certificate stating that you are enrolled at our university and that you have an address here.

When you get an appointment, please fill out this form and bring it with you to the vaccination appointment:

- Notification of appointments
- passport
- Vaccination certificate (if available)
